RENDITION PENALTY WAIVER REQUEST

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: This form is used to request a waiver of the rendition penalty. The request must be in writing, stating the grounds on which the penalty should be waived and must be accompanied by supporting documentation. The deadline to submit the penalty waiver request is 30 days after the date listed on the Notice of Penalty letter you received. If the waiver is denied, you will be notified and will be able to protest the denial. *Any request received after the deadline will be deemed late and will be automatically denied.*

Pursuant to Texas Tax Code, Sections 22.28 abd 22.29, if a person/business owner fails to file or to timely file a business personal property rendition, the Chief Appraisar must impose a penalty in an amount equal to 10 percent of the total amount of taxes imposed by the taxing units. The Chief Appraiser must also impose a 50 percent penalty if a person/business owner files a false statement or report with the intent to commit fraud or evade a tax. On written request by the property owner, the Chief Appraiser may waive the penalty imposed if the Chief Appraiser determines the the person/business owner exercised reasonable diligence to comply with or has substantially complied with the rendering requirements.
